#### **Clinic Equipment**

- Microscope
- Needles & Syringes – 5 / 3 / 10 Mills
- Cotton Wool
- Thermometers
- Blood Pressure Machines
- Glucometers
- Scale for adult height & weight
- Hanging scale for older children

#### **Clinic Supplies**

- Gauze Bandages, band-aids, bar soap
- Medical Scissors
- Cloth Diapers (No Disposable)
- Twin Size Flat Sheets
- Layettes - Include the following items in each layette:
  - 2 lightweight cotton shirts or Onesies® (or similar item)
  - 2 long- or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (with or without feet)
  - 2 receiving blankets, medium weight cotton/flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn (suggested size is 36" X 36")
  - 4 cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
  - One sweater or sweatshirt
  - 2 washcloths (full-size preferred)
  - Bath-size bar (4-5 oz.) of gentle soap, in its original wrapping
  - Two diaper pins OR two large, metal safety pins
- USB Memory Stick
- Printer for computer
- Batteries of all sizes

1. Go to [www.NTNL.org](http://www.NTNL.org) (Quick Links) for the latest list of items that are needed for the shipping container.
2. Pack items in unsealed boxes.
3. Bring a list of items in the boxes including quantity and description. For example:

15 boxes of chalk.

72 spiral notebooks.

12 Layettes (Includes: 2 diapers, 1 blanket,...)

If your church is giving a lot, please bring a thumb drive with this information in an Excel document where Column A is the quantity and Column B is the description.

4. Upon arrival at Assembly, ask where the Sierra Leone Container Drop Off area is located. Save yourself frustration by finding the Drop Off before lugging your boxes.
5. As the committee hopes to seal and ship the container Friday night, all donations must be at the Sierra Leone Container Drop Off area
