Your gift enables DiscipleLife Alive! to meet its \$3,000,000 goal:

- \$1,500,000 (50%) will support the newly developing NT-NL DiscipleLife Center for Mission at Briarwood for northern Texas and Louisiana, with state-of-the-art technology and updated classrooms, for training, equipping, and supporting laity and clergy to form a new generation of missional leaders for *DiscipleLife*.
- \$1,000,000 (33%) will provide a basis for the Mission Endowment Fund to identify mission opportunities to provide grants and scholarships to equip leaders for missional outreach where we worship, work, and live.
- \$300,000 (10%) will help complete construction of the Sierra Leone Jubilee Centre, providing global education opportunities.
- \$200,000 (7%) will support the program costs to conduct and implement the *DiscipleLife* initiative.
