



<p>What are the advantages of paying my bill online?</p>	<p>Paying online is secure, efficient, and it’s also good stewardship of our shared financial resources — because it helps lower the cost of bill processing. In addition, it’s a simple process with only a few steps. Other advantages of paying online include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Better accuracy, reducing errors – Payment is applied to your account faster – Flexibility to schedule a payment up to 60 days in advance – Health savings account (HSA) and retirement account contributions are deposited and invested faster – It saves postage and paper
<p>How do I encourage others to pay online?</p>	<p>Please encourage the congregations in your synod to pay online, so that as a community we can all work together to sustain the financial health of this church.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Thank congregations that are already paying online. – For congregations only paying their bill online some of the time, encourage them to use online bill pay more often. Remind them that they can be an even better steward of our shared financial resources by always paying online. – For congregations that aren’t paying online, encourage them to try and remind them it’s a simple process. Just sign in to EmployerLink, select <i>Administration</i>, then <i>Pay Your Bill</i>.
<p>How do I pay my bill online?</p>	<p>To pay your bill online, sign in to EmployerLink, select <i>Administration</i> and then <i>Pay Your Bill</i>. Just enter your payment amount and payment date. You’ll also need your bank routing number and account number.</p>
