## **Opportunities in Texas – Summer 2016**

Our volunteers are from all over the US, but we are reaching out to organizations in Texas for assistance in helping these camps come together. The following are camps to be held in Texas this summer. More may be added.

## **How can you help?**

Camp Noah is a largely volunteer run event. We rely on the help of congregations and groups all over the US to help us make many Camp Noahs happen each year at sites around the country. You can volunteer with us in a variety of ways.

*Lead a Team – Team Leaders recruit, fundraise, and lead a team of 15-25 volunteers at Camp Noah programs throughout the US. Stipend available for this position. Most churches use this as a mission trip opportunity for their congregation or youth groups.*

*Volunteer Camp Staff – Camp Volunteers join a team headed out to a week-long camp. Most teams are traveling some distance, so housing is provided at the camp location. Extra volunteers are always needed at camps.*

*Fleece Blankets and Kid Kits – All of our campers receive a fleece blanket and a Kid Kit (materials to be used during small group). These are important pieces of our curriculum and are usually donated by congregations and groups all over the US. We will need at least 250 fleece blankets and kid kits this summer in Texas alone.*

*We are happy to help you complete service or internship hours and we have experience working with a variety of requirements.*
