### Our History

Founded more than 100 years ago by servant leaders of the church, Mosaic continues into our second century as a ministry of faith. Mosaic was formed on July 1, 2003, by the consolidation of two Nebraska-based Lutheran ministries with shared mission, vision and Church affiliation.

Through the years, the organizations (Bethphage – founded in 1913 in Axtell, Neb. and Martin Luther Homes – founded in 1925 in Sterling, Neb.) expanded across the United States and to several other countries assisting individuals with intellectual disabilities to live a life of possibilities.

Mosaic is an affiliated social ministry organization of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, and a member of Lutheran Services in America.

### Services

Mosaic provides a life of possibilities through services that are tailored to the person's needs and desires. We ask people how they like to spend their day, what they love to do in their spare time, and what goals they would like to achieve. Then we partner with them to make those things happen.

Mosaic supports spiritual nurturing and growth. With the assistance of staff and volunteers, people are encouraged to participate in the religious services of their choice. Mosaic strives to work with all religions to promote inclusion within various faith communities.

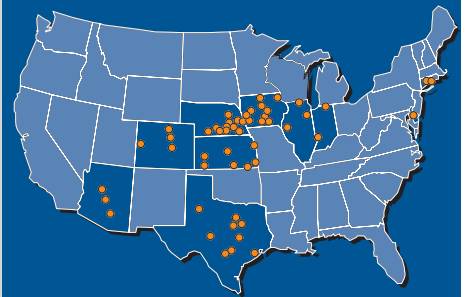

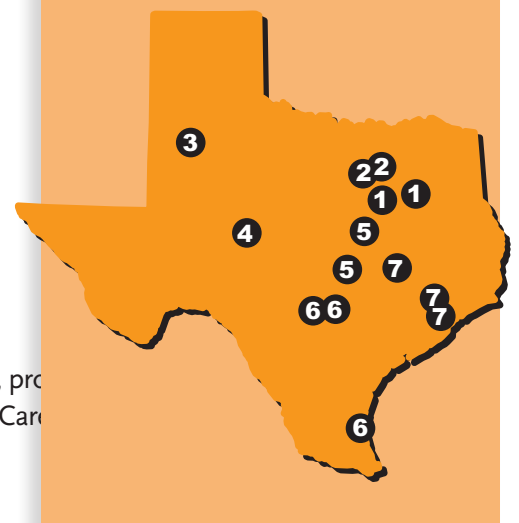
