Quart canning jars were decorated and then the above label was attached. The jars were distributed and each family/person was asked to contribute to the jar as they thought appropriate. Examples.....put the cost of a pop in the jar each day, put the cost of a meal in the jar each week, put all your loose change in the jar, etc.

Jars and the contents were returned one year later. Place a wheelbarrow or other metal tub at the front of the sanctuary. Before the offering read an appropriate Psalm or Litany and share some stories of how ELCA World and Domestic Hunger is making a difference in the lives of people across the globe. During the offering have the people come forward and pour the contents of their jars into the wheelbarrow/tub. It is good to have noise..... listen and rejoice at the noise of the money being poured in.

Ask people to keep their jars and continue to feed them for the next year.
