The ELCA Fund for Leaders scholarship program supports students of tremendous promise attending ELCA seminaries. By making seminary more affordable, the ELCA Fund for Leaders enables more future ministers to go to seminary and helps them graduate with less debt, empowering those whom God calls into ministry to go and serve as the church needs and the Holy Spirit leads. In the 2021-22 academic year, the ELCA Fund for Leaders provided scholarship assistance of more than \$3.2 million in support of 317 future pastors and deacons.

We are church, and each of us has a unique role to play in furthering the mission and ministry of the church. This year, we are also grateful for a separate scholarship in the name of Ascension Lutheran Church in Garland that funded an additional \$6600. They have left a legacy to their congregation that will continue to live on through this named scholarship for years to come.
