

## Northern Texas-Northern Louisiana Synod Assembly 2023 Report from Lutheran Foundation of the Southwest, Mark S. Armstrong, Executive Director

2022 was another record breaking year for LFSW. We did over \$27.66 million of legacy planning.

The total breakdown is as follows: \$333,933 of current gifts developed and paid out in 2022, \$1.67 million of currently funded endowments, charitable trusts, managed assets, and \$20.94 million of legacy gifts. We also worked with churches that invested over \$4.71 million in the ELCA Ministry Growth Fund.

We also paid out over \$1.51 million in endowment income and outright gifts to our Sponsors. In addition, we distributed \$476,004 to ELCA churches, \$219,084 to ELCA seminaries, and \$458,754 to other Lutheran and non–profit organizations.

Below is a breakdown of activity in 2022 for your organization and the churches in your synod. Current gifts, Trusts and endowments that were funded in 2022. Legacy gifts are gifts set up in the future.
