By making seminary more affordable, the ELCA Fund for Leaders enables more future ministers to go to seminary and helps them graduate with less debt, empowering those whom God calls into ministry to go and serve as the church needs and the Holy Spirit leads.

We are grateful that the Northern Texas – Northern Louisiana Synod Fund for Leaders has provided a total of \$65,467 in scholarships since its inception. While the amount available each year varies due to investment outcomes, during the 2023-24 academic year, the generosity of donors helped provide a total of \$10,200 in scholarship support. We are also grateful for a separate scholarship in the name of Ascension Lutheran in Garland that has funded a total of \$15,800 in scholarship support, with \$4100 of that during the 2023-34 academic year. They have left a legacy to their congregation that will continue to live on through this named scholarship for years to come.
